Entry and Eligibility: This regatta is open to all PHRF. Entry fee is \$13.

Anticipated Classes: Spinnaker and non-spinnaker PHRF ratings used. All skippers must complete an entry form at registration.

Sailing Area: The sailing area will be the Indian River Lagoon east of the Melbourne Yacht Club.
