You provide:

1. Wading shoes. Old tennis shoes, boat shoes or other closed shoes to protect your feet from river bottom debris. No sandals or flip-flops
2. Personal Flotation Device (Life Jacket)
3. Ability to swim 25 yds unassisted
4. Minimum age 16 years old. 14 or younger accepted if accompanied by adult in the class and the instructor concurs.

The class includes:

1. Textbook, "Start Sailing Right!" The official learn-to-sail book of US Sailing and the American Red Cross.
2. American Red Cross Certified Sailing Instructor
3. Use of a Sunfish sailboat for every two students
4. **Maximum 16 students per class. Register early, classes fill up quickly.**

- Class meets at the Upland Bldg in Sand Point Park, Titusville, Florida. Walk around the building and take the stairs up to the TSC Clubhouse on the 2nd Deck.
- **You will be sailing the first day!**
